

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** John Wells — Modifications by US Design Team

**START POSITION:** Standing facing appropriate post, both heels against start line, 10¾ oz. soup can with top cut out in strong hand.

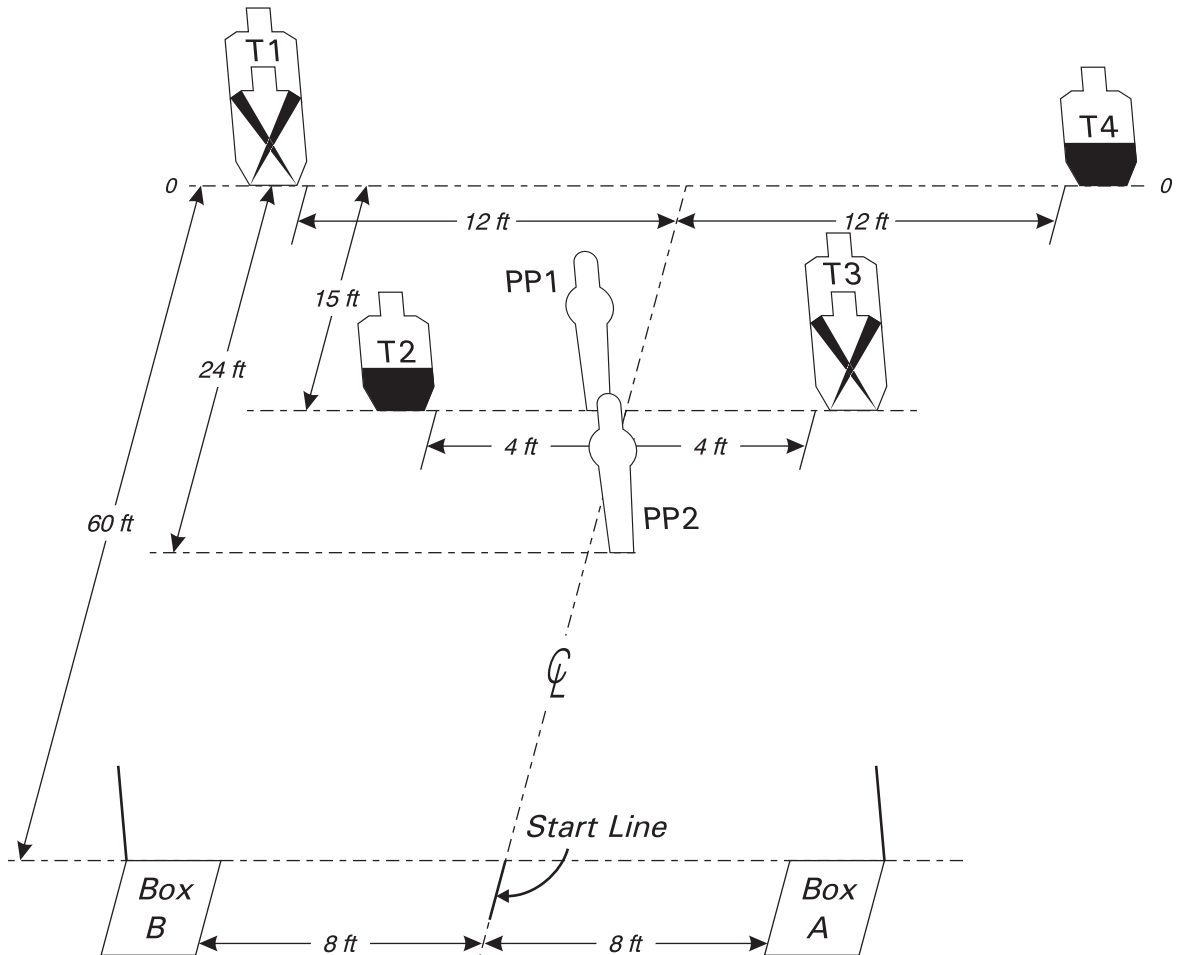
### STAGE PROCEDURE

- String 1. Upon start signal move to Box A and place can on post with strong hand, THEN draw and from Box A engage only T3, T4, PP1, and PP2
- String 2. Upon start signal move to Box B, place can on post with strong hand, THEN draw and from Box B engage only T1, T2, PP1 and PP2.

**R.O. Note:** Reset PP1 and PP2 between strings.

### SCORING

- SCORING:** Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points
- TARGETS:** 4 IPSC, 2 Pepper poppers
- SCORED HITS:** Best 2/paper, KD = 1 A
- START - STOP:** Audible - Last shot
- PENALTIES:** Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.
- Firing diagonally on wrong target array. -10 each shot.
  - Can not on post while firing. -10 each shot.
  - Touching gun before placing can on post. -10



**SETUP NOTES:** Paper targets are set to height of 5 feet at shoulders. No-shoots at T1 and T3 are set to middle of A zone on T1 and T3 respectively. Boxes A and B are 3 feet by 3 feet. A 3-foot-high 2-by-2 is nailed to their inner forward corners to hold the 10¾ oz. can.



Can has one end removed. Right edge of PP1 and left edge of PP2 are on centerline of range. Reset Pepper poppers between strings. Score after second string. Hard cover on T2 and T4 to lower A zone bottom perforation.
