



**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Rod Huff—Modifications by US Design Team

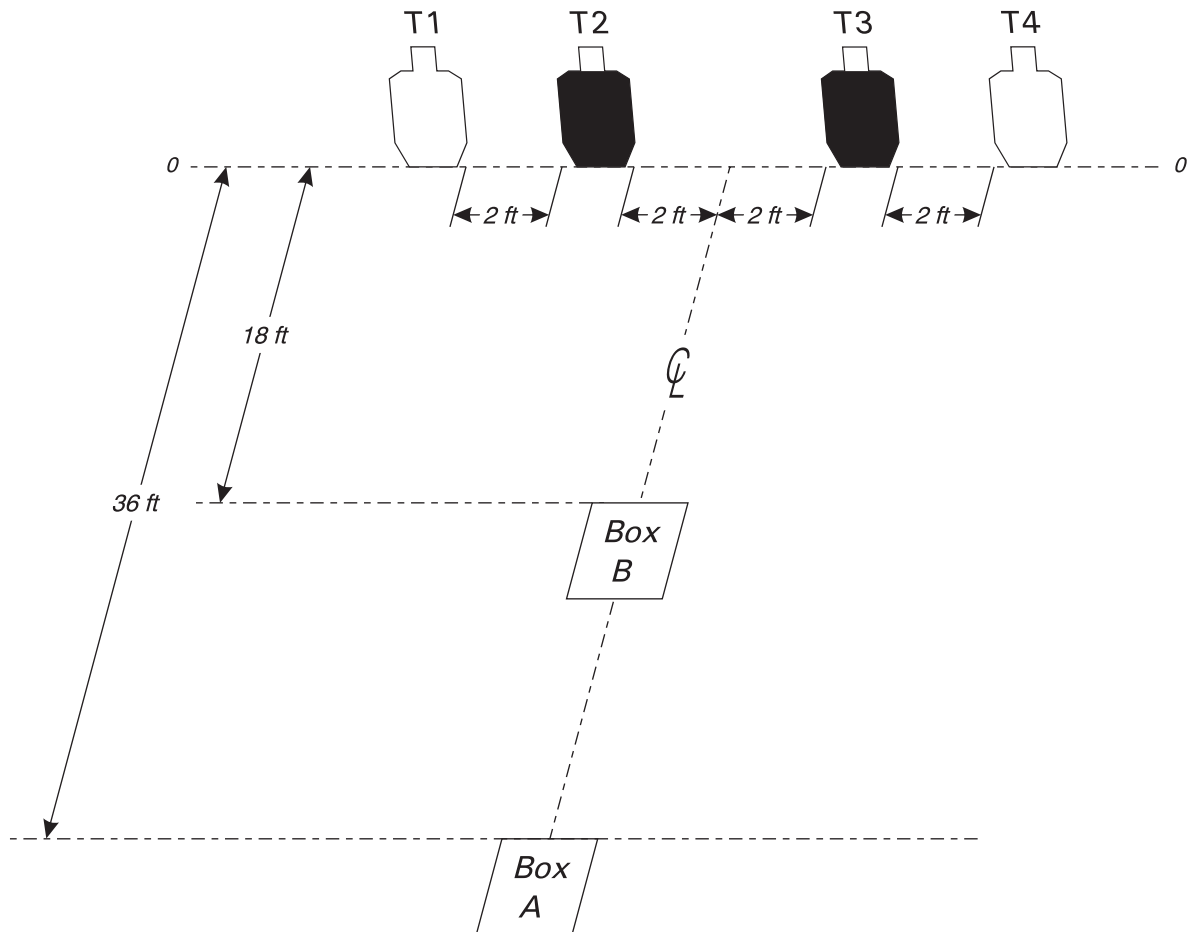
**START POSITION:** Standing in appropriate box, both arms hanging relaxed at sides.

### STAGE PROCEDURE

- String 1. Upon start signal, from Box A engage T1-T4 with only one round per target, then transfer gun to strong hand and from Box A engage T1 and T4 with only one round per target strong hand only.
  - String 2. Upon start signal, from Box B engage T1-T4 with only one round per target using strong hand only.
  - String 3. Upon start signal, from Box B engage T1-T4 with only one round per target, then transfer gun to weak hand and from Box B engage T1 and T4 with only one round per target weak hand only.
- Jams may be cleared with both hands.

### SCORING

- SCORING:** Virginia Count, 16 rounds, 80 points
- TARGETS:** 4 IPSC
- SCORED HITS:** Best 5/T1 & T4, Best 3/T2 & T3
- START - STOP:** Audible - Last shot
- PENALTIES:** Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.



**SETUP NOTES:** Targets are five feet high at shoulders. Shooting boxes are 3 feet by 3 feet.
