



RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Unknown

START POSITION: Standing behind fault line facing targets with both arms hanging relaxed at sides.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Competitors have 28 seconds to complete this stage. Upon start signal, from behind the fault line, engage T1-T3 with six rounds while standing, make a mandatory reload, and re-engage T1-T3 with six rounds while standing, make a second mandatory reload and reengage T1 - T3 with six rounds while prone, make a third mandatory reload and reengage T1-T3 with six rounds while prone.

RANGE OFFICER NOTES: All magazines used in this stage must begin on the belt. This stage will normally require four magazines. (Magazines resting on the ground may be used for reloads if placed on the ground after the start signal.)

SCORING

SCORING: Fixed Time, 24 rounds, 120 points

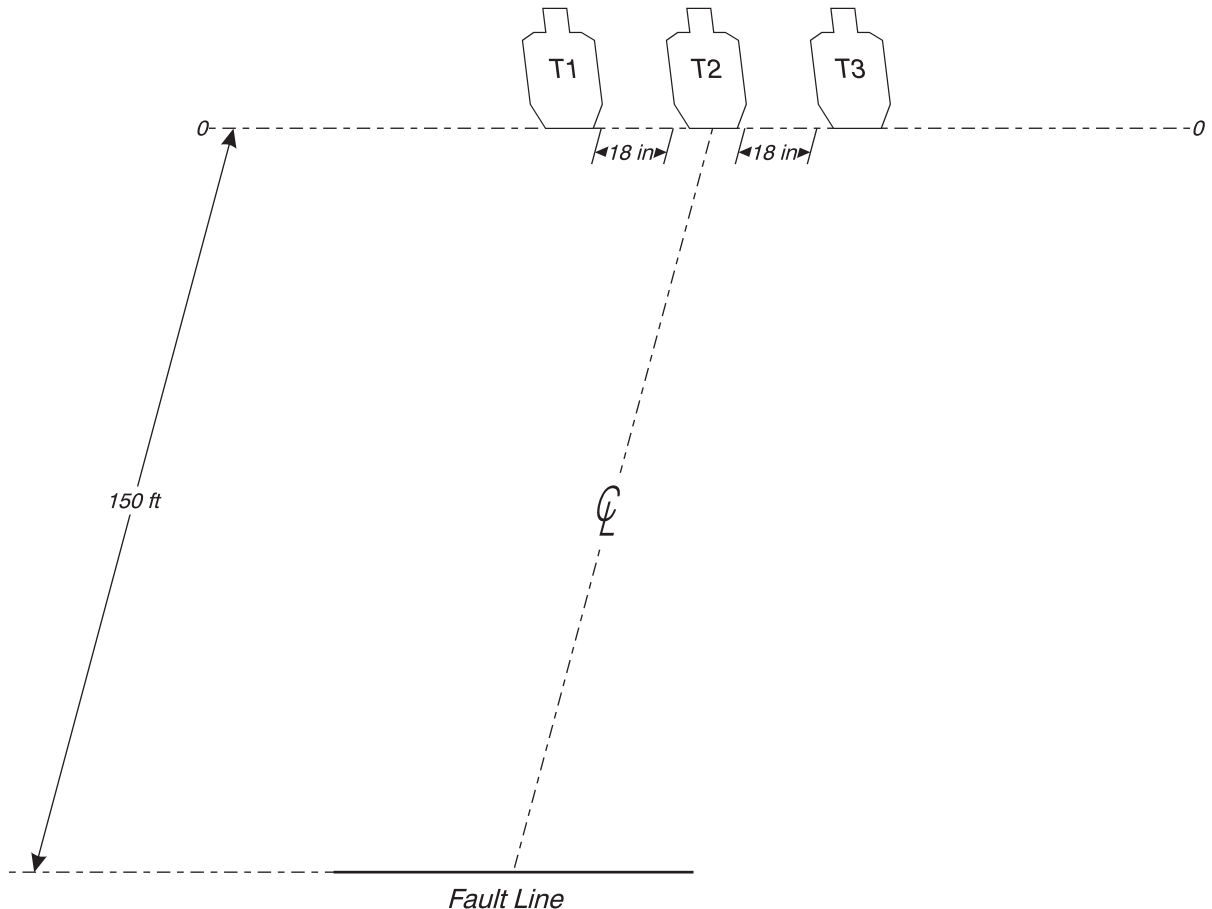
TARGETS: 3 IPSC

SCORED HITS: Best 8

START - STOP: Audible - Audible

PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook. Failure to perform the mandatory reload will result in one procedural per shot fired.

Set timer to sound at 28 seconds. Give one late shot penalty for each shot fired in excess of 28.30 seconds.



SETUP NOTES: Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders.

SCORE KEEPER NOTE: Record no-penalty misses on scoresheet for entry into scoring program.



TIMER NOTE: Allow .3 seconds for the horn on all timing. Example: 28 second string. 28.30 is NOT overtime, 28.31 is overtime.
