



**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Richard Westbrook—Mod. by US Design Team.

**START POSITION:** Standing in Box A with both arms fully extended, elbows locked as though putting a box on a high shelf.

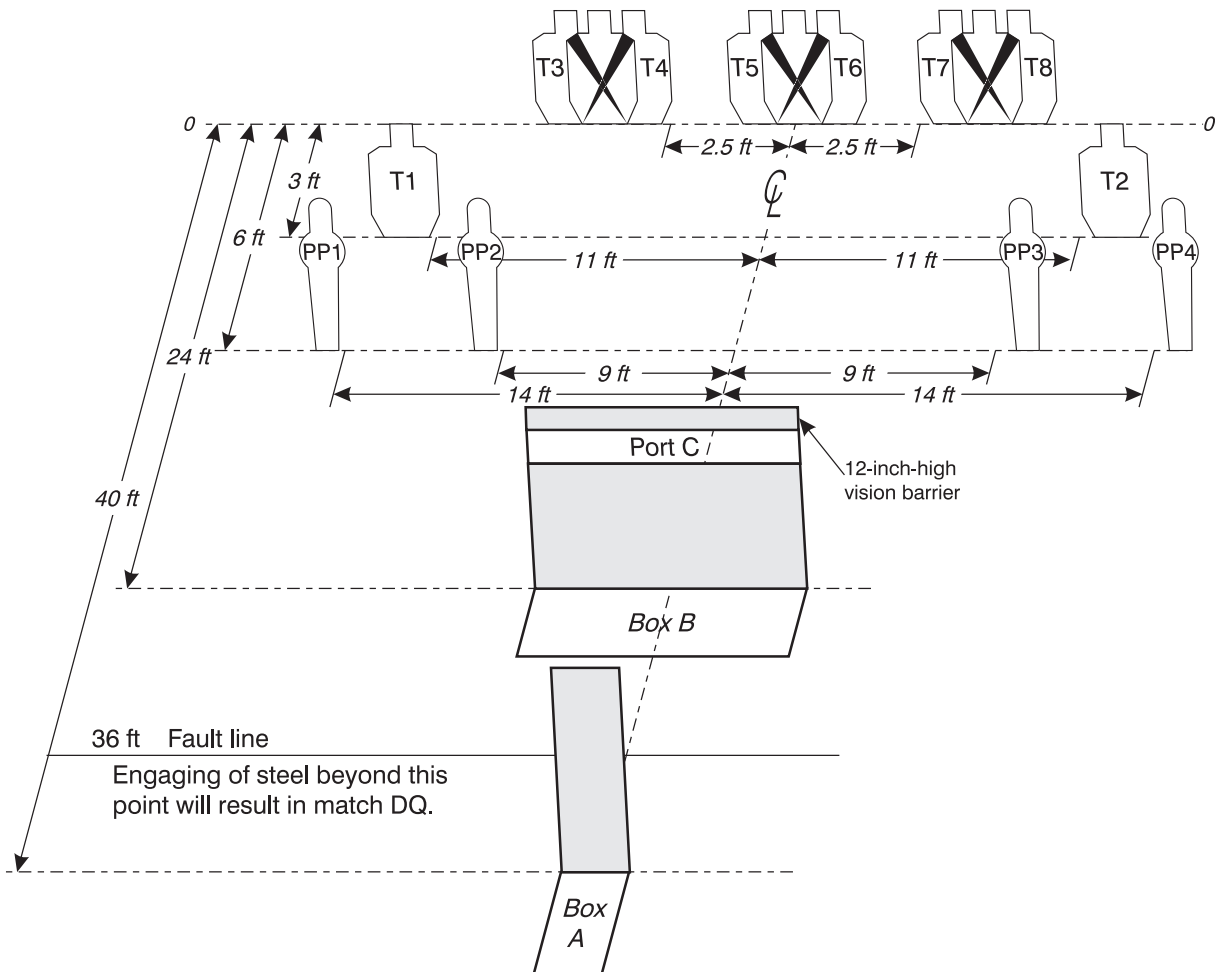
### STAGE PROCEDURE

EACH TARGET REQUIRES ONLY ONE HIT.  
ONLY THE BEST HIT WILL BE SCORED.

Upon start signal, from Box A, engage only T1, PP1, and PP2 from the left side of the barricade. From Box A engage only T2, PP3, and PP4 from the right side of the barricade. Then move to Box B and from Box B, through Port C, engage only T3-T8. Engaging steel from closer than 10 yards will result in a match DQ under 12.01.

### SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points  
**TARGETS:** 8 IPSC, 4 Pepper poppers  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 1/paper, KD = 1 A  
**START - STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Per current edition of USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.



**SETUP NOTES:** Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Outer scoring line of no-shoots between T3-T4, T5-T6, and T7-T8 overlay A-zone scoring lines of shoot targets. (Non-scoring borders of no-shoots are inside of A zones.) Box A is 2-by-3-feet behind a



standard 2-by-6-foot barricade. Box B is 4-by-8-feet behind a 4-by-8-foot barricade with a 1-by-8-foot port on top. Add an additional 1-by-8-foot vision barrier above the port.
