



RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Tampa C.P.L. —Modifications by US Design Team

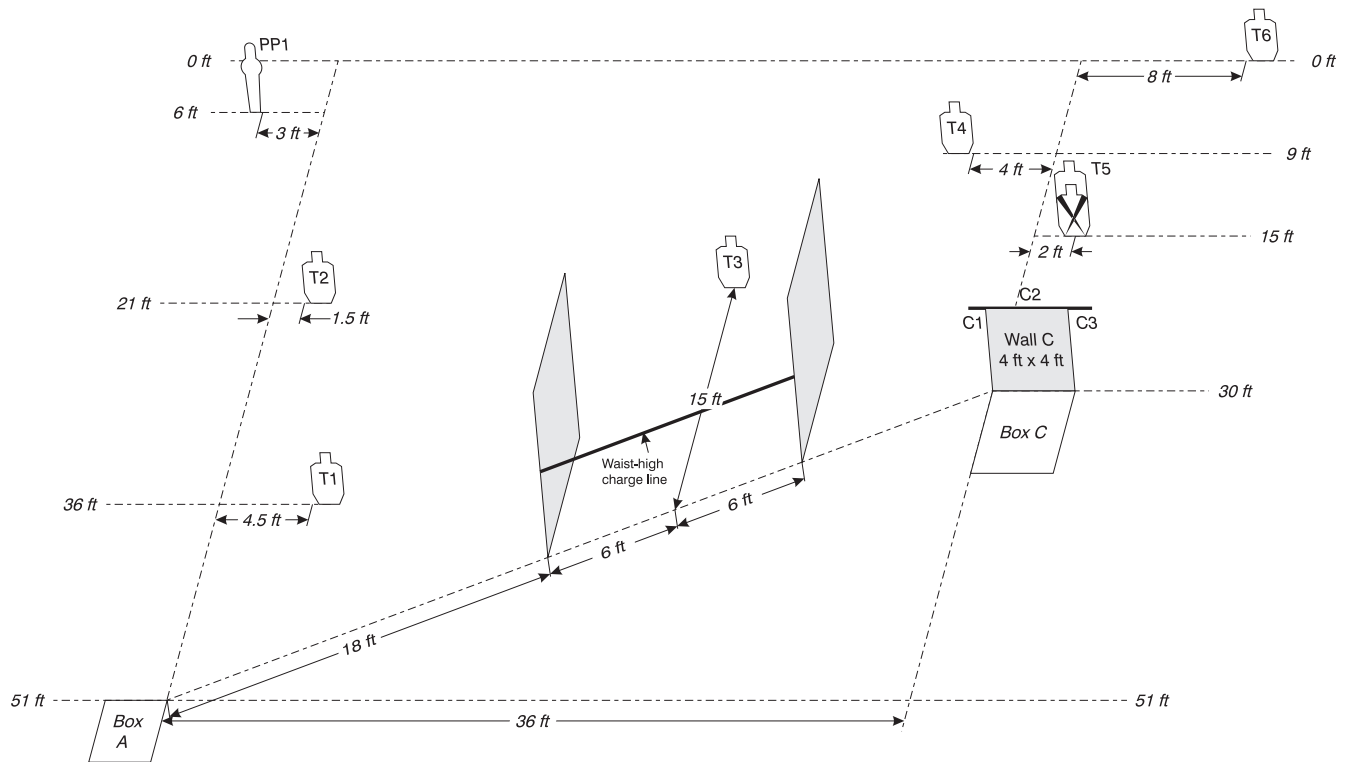
START POSITION: Standing in Box A facing targets with both arms hanging relaxed at sides.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, from Box A, engage only T1, T2, and PP1 in any order. Move toward Box C and engage only T3 from between vision barriers and behind charge line. From Box C engage only T4 from position C1, only T5 from position C2, and only T6 from position C3. All vision barriers and walls are defined as hard cover.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 13 rounds, 65 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC, 1 Pepper popper
SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper, KD = 1 A
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.



SETUP NOTES: Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Top scoring line of no-shoot at T5 is set to middle of A zone. Vision barriers are 6 feet by 8 feet with a waist-high charge line across the front. Barriers may be made of plastic or cloth. Nail a 6-foot-long 2-



by-4 flat across the top of wall C with the ends extending 12 inches to either side of the barricade. T5 is centered on Wall C. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet. Box C is 4 feet by 4 feet.
